- Secure the Land Matt feels we need to get the survey process underway so it can be started in the spring.

- Lang Locks Michael went to Lang Locks. They have a call out charge of \$100 and a charge of \$30 per cylinder. Michael made a motion to proceed with getting Lang Locks to come out and proceed with a firm quote to change our locks. Seconded Christine. Carried.
- Loppet Committee Meeting Lori Lori provided the discussion from the Loppet Committee meeting. After looking at many loppets it appears there are a range of possibilities. The executive were in favor of a focus on participation. Christine made a motion to have the loppet with a classic and skate ski distance of 5, 10, 17, and 34 km and a snowshoe distance of 3 and 5km. Seconded Randy. Carried. Lori will arrange for Zone 4 and is going to investigate lunch options. There was discussion about swag and pricing. Lori will look into this.
- BMFF Update Christine Both Saturday and Sunday were sold out, with Monday at 93% sold. The total amount raised for the club should be around \$15,000. There are still invoices to come in from GPRC. Thanks to Christina and Geo for all their work on the film fest.

- Calforex Update Michael Things are getting lined up for the race. There are some previous and also some new volunteers. High Tech has donated a printer, Custom Communications a communication hub, County Pump Out the portapotties, IPaper photocopying, Strasdin Orthodontics as well as Rocky Mountain Chocolate. The forecast is for good weather with good snow conditions.
- Membership Stats Michael Michael provided information from Zone 4 about our membership. There are many who indicate they use the dog trails, as well as many snowshoers. Christine is working on putting a "day pass purchase" on the webpage.
- Environmental Stewardship Committee Christine will put a note in the newsletter to ask for volunteers for this committee.

Justin at the county is looking into the changes. Lori suggested that we regularly review our insurance for changes. Matt was going to research what other groups do for bike insurance.
- Colour Run Randy Randy was just at a meeting preparing for the Colour Run in May. They had asked him what the absolute maximum would be. The number previously given of 750 is our limit now as we don't know if we can handle that many. Randy said they are planning on having no parking, but only shuttles if the number is higher than last uear.
