

WNSC Trail/Infrastructure Enhancement Review Process

Development or rehabilitation of trails or infrastructure is wanted

- Will the enhancement change the skill level of the trail?
- Does the enhancement involve 10cm+ ground disturbance or tree removal?
- Does the enhancement include off trail brush removal?
- Does the enhancement require funding over \$1000 or WNSC equipment?
- Will the enhancement conflict with other WNSC users?

Send The Trails Director a request for approval. Important details to include Who, What, Where, When, & Why. The goal is to respond within 7 days of submission with approval or reason for not approving.

If Approved. The Trails Director or designate will send the request to a committee. The committee will including all affected stakeholders. Final approval might be required by the WNSC board.

The Trails Director will communicate the committee/WNSC board feedback to the requester.

Send the Trails Director a request for approval. Important details to include Who, What, Where, & When. The goal is to respond within 7 days of submission with approval or reason for not approving.

Approved Maintenance Activity's ready to execute!

- Post to WNSC FB Page including a brief project description including who what where when why
- Follow up Post to WNSC FB Page reporting the success of the project once complete

- Email Trails Director including a brief project description including intentions to start work and when. Trails Director will post to WNSC FB Page.
- Email Trails Director to report the success of the project once complete. Trails Director will post to WNSC FB Page.
