1: Summer Trails Plan: Objective is to create two (2) trails that criss cross (and stay off the ski trails) making one big loop.

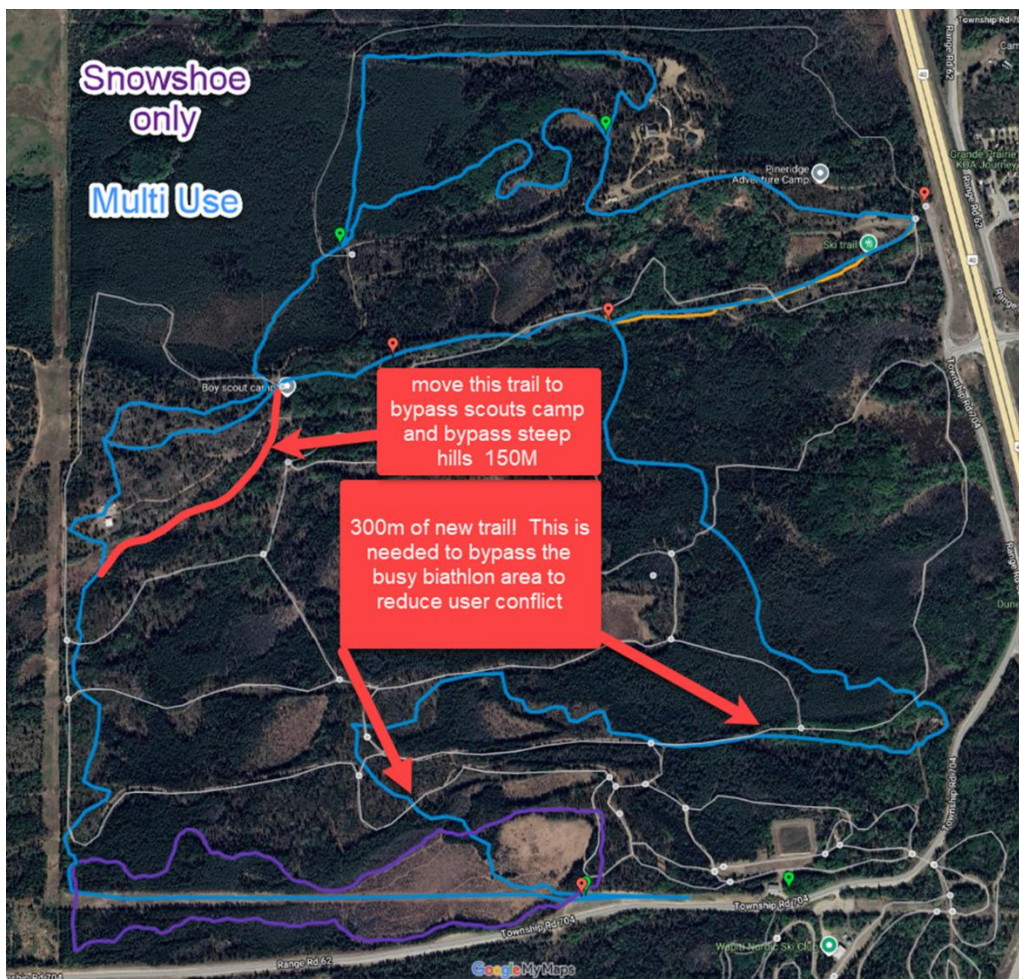


- Will be multi directional
- Will have specific trail signage (names / symbol)
- Junctions will be alphabetical so not confused with ski trails numerical junctions
- All Green trails
- New trails will start as single track, can widen
- Wide enough for flail mower @ 4ft
- With education and signage, it should be easier to promote and be more uptake
- Some hand work, some with mini backhoe



- 60% has to be built
- Have to write an agreement with Scouts
- Piece it out and just do the North / proof of concept /
- Did talk to trail builders
- Consensus that those attending had enough confidence to allow Matt to follow the general route and deal with minor issues as we go.
- Trails would be OPTIMIZED for mountain biking but open to other uses

2: Winter Trails Plan (shown as blue = multi use; purple = snowshoeing)



- 90% in place
- 300m new trails
- Future new parking lot west on the hill to keep people off biathlon XC trails
- Only mark for winter in winter

3: Next steps:

1. Seek final board approval
2. Finalize agreements for trail use with Scouts
3. Apply for TFA from Alberta Forestry and Parks
4. Build trail routes over spring, summer, and, fall
5. Install signage as required for navigation and risk management
6. Finalize map and post in park area and key intersections
7. Maintain/Improve/enhance trails over time
